Caring Staff

Our staff are state licensed child care professionals trained in child safety, curriculum, leadership, and more. Prior to working in any YMCA Child Care program, staff must complete a fingerprint and background check. All YMCA Child Care staff are certified in CPR and First Aid, and receive additional training in child abuse prevention and bloodborne pathogens.

Providing Homework Support

We know how important it is for you and your child to receive quality homework support during our YMCA Child Care programs. We provide a quiet and suitable place to do homework, along with needed materials and a staff team who is readily available at all sites.

Our goal is to provide opportunities for children to develop early computer literacy skills, explore educational resources on the internet and aid in homework support through computers and internet connectivity at all of our sites.

Licensing and Accreditation

Our Child Care programs are licensed through the State of California Community Care Licensing Division. Each child care location is visited by a Licensing Representatives on a regular basis to ensure we are providing a safe and healthy environment for children in our care. We also are committed to attaining National Afterschool Association accreditation at all YMCA Child Care programs.
